



## Transition To Work Boost Workshop

During November, Transition to Work, an employment services program supporting young people aged 15 to 21, ran their first round of BOOST workshops for participants who are currently not engaged in study or employment.

The workshop is designed to give the participants a 'boost' of confidence with their job search, career decision making and social interaction. The group discusses topics like goal setting, how to make a resume stand out, how to answer interview questions, labour market shortages, and what regions are having the most difficulty securing workers. The workshops were broken up into fun activities, quirky videos, group discussion and workbooks.

Brittany Lanam, the newest TtW team member runs the workshops over a four week period, with a new workshop starting every month. Brittany provides an open and inviting environment for the participants to feel comfortable, a space where they can come to learn in an informal setting, with snacks provided to keep them going! Week four provides the participants with an external activity where they can develop team building skills, communication and problem solving.

Transition to Work received referrals from Centrelink and jobactive providers and can also accept direct registrations from young people who are not in receipt of Youth Allowance. They speak with local employers, advising them about the government incentives available when hiring young people, arrange Internships, work experience, courses, driving lessons, other work related work licences as well as a host of other assistance.
