INDIVIDUAL SUPPORT - AGEING

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About this course

At IMPACT Community Services, we offer comprehensive face-to-face courses with hands-on training. Our equipped facilities include simulated ward environments. This qualification is for individuals who provide person-centered support in community and/or residential settings for aging individuals. To complete the qualification (CHC33021 Certificate III in Individual Support - Ageing), you must fulfil 120 hours of vocational placement.

Participants will engage in theory, practical assessments, and vocational placement to achieve certification. This qualification provides a pathway to work in roles such as a personal care worker, aged care support worker, home care assistant, and residential aged care worker.

Funding

FUNDING ASSISTANCE

Funding assistance may be available for individuals who meet the following eligibility criteria:

- Age 15 or older and have completed or left secondary school (including home schooling)
- Permanent residency in Queensland
- Australian citizenship, Australian permanent residency (including humanitarian entrant), temporary residency with the necessary visa and work permits on the pathway to permanent residency, or New Zealand citizenship
- Not currently enrolled in training, including Vocational Education and Training (VET) and higher education courses

SKILLING QUEENSLANDERS FOR WORK (SQW) FULLY FUNDED PROGRAMS

SQW offers fully funded programs, such as Get Set for Work and Community Work Skills, covering all course costs, including uniforms, for eligible students. Second chance funding is available for individuals holding a Certificate III or higher. Centrelink payment is not required to access this funding. Please contact us for more details regarding SQW eligibility.

CERTIFICATE 3 GUARANTEE - SUBSIDISED FUNDED PROGRAM

The Certificate 3 Guarantee program provides subsidised training places to Queenslanders, enabling them to obtain their first Certificate III qualification in priority training areas. Accessing this government funding may affect your eligibility for further subsidised training in the future. To be eligible, you must not hold or be enrolled in a Certificate III or higher qualification.

CERTIFICATE 3 GUARANTEE - STUDENT CONTRIBUTION

- Concession: \$3 | Non-concession: \$5 | Maximum cost: Concession: \$45 | Non-concession: \$75
- Students will also need to purchase a uniform, which costs approximately \$30 to \$40.

OTHER STUDENTS

If you are ineligible for the above-mentioned funding options, please speak to us about external funding assistance that may be available. The full course cost is \$3150, and a payment plan may be negotiated for those paying the full amount. Students will also need to purchase a uniform.

Entry requirements

Students will require suitable technology to access the course and submit assessments. Students will also require one or all of the following checks for undertaking the mandatory vocational placement component of the course: National Police Check, NDIS Screening Card, Blue Card for working with children, possess or eligible to obtain USI (Unique Student Identifier).
