- Not be enrolled in training (including vocational education and training (VET) and higher education courses and program eligibility

SQW will pay **all** course costs, including uniforms, for students who meet SQW eligibility. This includes second chance funding if you already have a Certificate III or higher. You do not need to be in receipt of Centrelink payments to access this funding. (ask our friendly staff for details of SQW eligibility)

C3G provides Queenslanders with access to government subsidised training places, up to and including their first Certificate III level qualification in priority training areas. Accessing this government funding may reduce your ability to receive further subsidised training in the future.
