PRIMARY CLINIC

Our primary clinic is situated at 2 Rafting Ground Road, Agnes Water and offers a range of clinical and allied health appointments and programs.

Unless stated otherwise in *Our Service Streams*, our full range of services and programs are offered at this location.

OUTREACH CLINICS

Some of our services are provided under an outreach service delivery model as described in *Our Service Streams*.

Our outreach clinics are provided in the north and south of the region:

- Northern Clinics
 - Miriam Vale OzCare building, Roe Street.
 - o Turkey Beach Community Centre.
- Southern Clinics
 - Baffle Creek Sport and Rec Ground.
 - Lowmead Hall.
 - Rosedale Hall.

HOME VISITS

Home visits may be accommodated in specific circumstances where the client is:

- Home-bound unable to leave the premises;
- Unable to travel due to medical reasons; or
- Requiring an in-home assessment.

A Home Visit Risk Assessment must be undertaken prior to staff visiting and appropriate controls will be put in place to ensure our staff safety.

It is our usual practice for two staff members to attend a first home visit where the client is new to our service.

TELEHEALTH

We provide clients with Telehealth/Skype services which enable clients to receive specialist care closer to home via telecommunication technology, reducing the need for travel to regional centres.

Nurse-led telehealth is also available which allows the health professional to receive any preliminary observations that may be required (for instance your blood pressure or heart rate) from the nurse prior or during the appointment.





My healthcare rights

This is the second edition of the **Australian** Charter of Healthcare Rights.

These rights apply to all people in all places where health care is provided in Australia.

The Charter describes what you, or someone you care for, can expect when receiving health care.





AUSTRALIAN COMMISSION ON SAFETY AND QUALITY IN HEALTH CARE safety and quality.gov.au/your-rights

I have a right to:

Access

Healthcare services and treatment that meets my needs

Safety

- Receive safe and high quality health care that meets national standards
- . Be cared for in an environment that is safe and makes me feel safe

Respect

- . Be treated as an individual, and with dignity and respect
- . Have my culture, identity, beliefs and choices recognised and respected

Partnership

- Ask questions and be involved in open and honest communication
- . Make decisions with my healthcare provider, to the extent that I
- Include the people that I want in planning and decision-making

Information

- . Clear information about my condition, the possible benefits and risks of different tests and treatments, so I can give my informed consent

 Receive information about services, waiting times and costs
- Be given assistance, when I need it, to help me to understand and use health information
- Access my health information
- Be told if something has gone wrong during my health care, how it happened, how it may affect me and what is being done to make

Privacy

Have my personal privacy respected

Have information about me and my health kept secure and confidential

Give feedback

- Provide feedback or make a complaint without it affecting the way
- that I am treated Have my concerns addressed in a transparent and timely way
- Share my experience and participate to improve the quality of care and health services

HEALTH CARE RIGHTS

The Australian Charter of Healthcare Rights second edition applies to all people in all places where health care is provided. The Charter describes what you can expect when receiving health care.

As a client of Impact Community Health Service, you have the responsibility to:




